



THE ANNUAL BAMS WEEKEND CONFERENCE
Oxford, 24th - 26th June 2016

Full residential fee - £ 275 per person

Includes Friday and Saturday night accommodation in halls of residence at the university. Rooms will be allocated at time of booking. All have ensuite facilities. The fee includes all receptions, breakfasts, lunches, dinners and events. Delegates requiring double rooms should book early as such rooms are scarce.

Reduced rate residential fee - £235 per person

Includes accommodation for Friday and Saturday nights in university accommodation in Walton Street. The rooms are single occupancy only, and have shared facilities. The fee includes all receptions, breakfasts, lunches, dinners and events.

Those wishing to stay for additional nights in university accommodation at their own expense should contact Janet Larkin (jlarkin@britishmuseum.org) to see if this can be arranged.

Non-residential fee - £175 per person

The fee includes all lunches and receptions and Saturday evening dinner, but please note that it does not include the dinner on the Friday evening.

Student rate, non-residential - £150 per person

The fee includes all lunches and receptions and Saturday evening dinner, but please note that it does not include the dinner on the Friday evening.
